The High School Youth Group Needs YOUR Help!



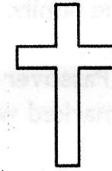

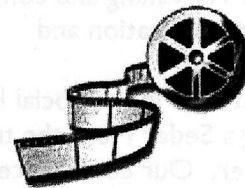
